## Minutes of the Crystal Falls Association Board of Directors Meeting April 17, 2014 12:00pm

The meeting was called to order by Martha Wilson, President. Other directors in attendance were, Allan Beck, Vice President, Jeannette Sedlemeyer, Secretary, Delphine Tipper, Treasurer, Roger Mattson, Director.
